Free trips, free after school clubs, free holiday clubs

Your school could receive up to **£1455** per year, for each child from a family on low income. This is called the **Pupil Premium**. The school uses it to plan and support learning opportunities, provide additional resources to support home learning and provide targeted interventions.

Your child could be eligible if you are receiving one of the following benefits:

- [Income support \(IS\)](#)
- [Income Based Jobseekers Allowance \(JSA\(IB\)\)](#)
- [Income-related Employment and Support Allowance \(ESA\(IR\)\)](#)
- [Child Tax Credit](#), provided you are not entitled to [Working Tax Credit](#) and have an annual income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) that does not exceed **£16,190**.
- [The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit](#).
- [Universal Credit](#)
