Go on an autumn walk and collect signs of autumn. Write some sentences about your walk.

Draw or make a collage picture of a wild animal. Use scraps of materials, ribbons, buttons, etc. or natural materials.

Research and write two sentences about tigers. Remember to use capital letters and full stops.

Practise writing numbers correctly (without reversals 1-10). Make a set of digit cards (use the back of a cereal box) 1-10 and then 11-20. Order them, find missing numbers, count things to match the number.

Create an animal alphabet. Can you think of an animal for each letter of the alphabet?

Collect together some of the toy animals you have at home (fluffy or plastic). Talk/find out about the animals and think about the similarities and differences between them.

Draw or take a picture of your pet or a pet you would like to have. Find out facts about your pet, e.g. food it eats, where it sleeps, etc. You could label your picture with some of these facts
