What do aliens think of life on Planet Earth?



Draw around the feet of everybody in your family. Choose something in your house to measure the length of each foot i.e (Lego, penne pasta, anything that you have lots of that is the same length). Can you use the language of longer than and shorter than to compare? E.g. My foot is shorter than your foot.

Could you plant some seeds? This could be inside or in the garden. You could plant flower, fruit or vegetable seeds. Watch for signs of growth and don't forget to water them.

Can you practise counting up to 50? This could be while walking along, use different household items such as pasta, buttons, Smarties etc? Alongside these activities support your child to practice writing the 2 digit numbers.

Can you go for a Spring walk and look for Spring flowers and leaves?

Can you make up some alien words for Beegu using any phonemes you know? How about words with a split diagraph? E.g. for i-e you could have the word strime.

Please complete one or more of these activities each week.
