

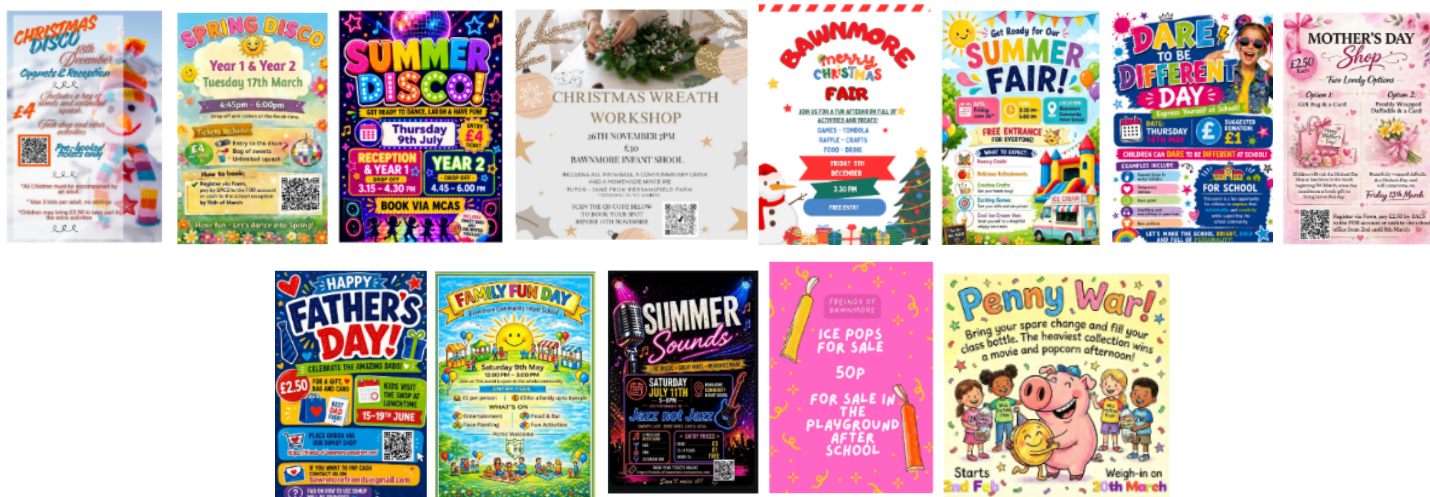
And that's a wrap folks!
